### **\*Silent Auction Information and Rules\***

The silent auction will begin at 9:30 a.m. in Booth #63 and end promptly at 2:00 p.m. Payment and pick up of merchandise will begin at 2:30 p.m. Sign up at the silent auction booth to participate in bidding. A bid sheet will be displayed for each item. Bids can be entered by writing your assigned number on the bid sheet with your bid amount. Items must be claimed within an hour after the close of the auction. For those people who wish to purchase and take items home immediately (cash & carry), take advantage of our "buy-it-now" feature (not available for all auction items).

Please note minimum starting bids and minimum increases on the bid sheets. Each new bid must be written on the first available line on the bid sheet and must be in increments as indicated on the bid sheet. The highest bid at closing time becomes the winning bid. As Silent Auction bids exceed the "buy-it-now" dollar amounts, the "buy-it-now" options shall no longer be valid. In the event of a dispute, a member of the auction committee will determine the winner.

Only cash, cashier's checks and credit card payments will be accepted. All sales are final. There will be no exchanges or refunds. For assistance, please inquire with the silent auction chairpersons at the silent auction booth.
